

## What is Waste2Wear Blockchain?

Waste2Wear Blockchain is a supply chain traceability system using technology that records all the steps of the recycling and production process (from plastic waste to product). It combines digital records with physical proofs and inspections in order to secure the compliance and transparency of whole supply chain.

## What's in it for me?

- Transparency of the supply-chain
- Veracity of digital records through physical proofs
- Source and journey of the recycled materials: from waste to product
- Compliance and certifications of each supplier involved in the chain

## How does Blockchain work if I only buy fabric?

We guarantee our blockchain from bottle collection to the end of our GRS certified supply chain. If you only need our fabric, you will receive a QR code leading your customers to an image of the fabric we have produced for you. Scan the two QR codes to see the difference.

## What if I want to extend the Blockchain to show the finished product?

If you buy our fabrics and have them made into finished products elsewhere, we can extend the blockchain for you. Prior to ordering, discuss your requirements clearly with your Waste2Wear sales agent. To extend the blockchain from our supply chain through yours, each of your suppliers must complete and return a Waste2Wear Blockchain Supplier Approval Form to your sales agent. Our blockchain teams in China and India will conduct a physical audit for each order, including document verification, facility inspection and blockchain system training to ensure that your supply chain is certified and environmentally compliant. Once complete, your supplier will receive a Waste2Wear Blockchain Certificate as per the example below and Waste2Wear blockchain credentials to access the system.

When your supplier has been certified it can be included in the Waste2Wear Geolocation System for orders for the duration of 12 months. After this period the certificate must be renewed.



## What if my own supply chain is in another country?

If you buy our fabric and have it made into finished products in another country, it makes sense to arrange virtual audits. These must adhere to very strict terms to ensure that the entire blockchain remains at the same standard as within the Waste2Wear supply chain.

Virtual audits are only acceptable when live audits are not possible as they are more laborious.

## How much does the extended Blockchain cost?

**A:** Waste2Wear customers extended blockchain to non-Waste2Wear supply chain:

- o Inspection per transaction\* (barcode and QR code) between factories: US\$ 350 (live or virtual, per mandate, not including travel expenses)
- o Annual audit fee per factory: US\$ 3,200 (not including travel expenses)

**B:** Non-Waste2Wear customers that want to verify their full supply chain with the Waste2Wear blockchain technology while not using Waste2Wear products.

- o Inspection per transaction\* (barcode and QR code) between factories: US\$ 350 (live or virtual, per mandate, not including travel expenses)
- o Annual audit fee per factory: US\$ 3,200 (not including travel expenses)
- o Annual license partner fee: US\$ 20,000
